

THE KEY TO HEAVEN

Genesis 1-2



GENESIS 1

The Bible begins with a sort of poem about the story of Creation (how things, and we, were made). It starts with a darkness, with just the 'Spirit of God' (a fancy way of saying the Holy Spirit) hovering over the 'waters' (Genesis 1:2). It then goes on to say how God created light, then the sky, then land and plants, then the Sun, moon and stars, then the creatures of the air and sea, then the creatures of the land. All of these He calls 'good' (Genesis 1:4, 12, 18, 21, 25). Then He comes to His last creation. 'Then God said, "Let us make

humankind in our image, according to our likeness; and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the wild animals of the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth." (Genesis 1:26). So God creates humans out of the dust of the earth. And when God sees this work, he says it is VERY good (or "me'od good" in Hebrew). Finally, on the seventh day, God rests.





GENESIS 2

God plants a garden in the east, which he calls Eden. He places the human being (in Hebrew, Adam) in the garden and gives him authority over the animals and plants in the Garden of Eden. In the middle of the garden, there are two trees; the Tree of Life, and the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. It also tells us that there are 4 rivers that water this amazing garden (Pi'shon, Gi'hon, Tigris and Euphrates. Remember these, especially the last one, as these will pop up throughout the Bible.) Adam is told that he is free

to eat of any of the trees in the garden, except the tree of The Knowledge of Good and Evil, from which he is not allowed to eat. If he does, he will die (Cruel). God tells Adam to name all the animals around him and tries to find a partner for him. However, seeing how none of them suite, He makes him fall into a deep sleep. He takes one of Adam's ribs and makes out of it 'a woman' (Genesis 2:22). Thus, the woman was made.

Reflection

We are told that each of us is made in His own image. We are made in the image of God! Of all the creatures God creates, we are the only ones He creates that can stand up to Him and praise him facing towards where He is. But that privilege comes with a responsibility. Many people abuse the gift of free will to hurt others. People are killed and injured each day by wars and conflicts in our beautiful world which God created. We have no right to hurt others, both physically and spiritually. The first reason is that we are all made in the image of God, so when we hurt others, it is an offence against God Himself. Secondly, since God is love (1 John 4:8), and we are all made in the image of God, we should love others, and not hurt them. We should never bully others at school, talk back at our parents, hurt our siblings, talk behind backs and give pain to people around us. Always remember to give others a helping hand, because Jesus will tell at the second coming, 'Whatever you did for the least of these my brothers, you did it for me.' (Matthew 25:40).
